

June 6, 2016
Regular Session

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Glenn Wright. Members present were Mr. Miller, Mr. McWhorter, Mrs. Wynn, Mr. Lewis, and Mr. Moore.

Mr. Miller opened the meeting with prayer.

Mr. Miller made a motion to approve the May 16, 2016 Regular Session minutes as presented with a correction, after a second by Mr. McWhorter the motion passed 4-0-1 with Mr. Moore abstaining.

Cail Hammons and Kendrick Ward gave an update on the Main Street Program.

Freddie gave a presentation on a new electronic reading system for all residential water meters. The life expectancy of a water meter is 10 years and the current system is now 11 years old. Dave Thomas, a representative from Georgia Power was present to explain how this system works and to answer any questions. He stated that this system will better serve customers and is designed to give very detailed information concerning usage, leaks, and tampering. He stated that the system is accurate and will cut down on customer complaints. No action was taken. It was decided to schedule a work session to gain a better understanding of the new system.

Mr. Miller made a motion to enter into an agreement with Southland Paving Company for paving improvements to Ivy Lane and Brighton Road to be paid with SPLOST funds, after a second by Mr. Lewis the motion passed 5-0.

Mr. Moore made a motion authorizing Mayor Wright to execute all documents as approved by the City Attorney necessary for the USDA Rural Business Development Grant for the Streetscape Improvements, after a second by Mrs. Wynn the motion passed 5-0.

John McGarity addressed a notice he received concerning code violations at his property on West Street. He stated that Anderson Environmental of Stockbridge will scrape and paint the exterior, Dan Jones will board up all openings and make all repairs, and Ricky Easley will cut and maintain the grass.

Mr. Lewis made a motion to approve a resolution for Sunday Sales of Beer and Wine by the package to be placed on the November referendum, after a second by Mr. Miller the motion passed 5-0.

Mr. Lewis made a motion to enter into executive session, after a second by Mr. McWhorter the motion passed 5-0.

No action was taken in Executive Session one legal matter was discussed. Mr. Miller made a motion authorizing Mayor Wright to sign an affidavit regarding Executive Session, after a second by Mr. Moore the motion passed 5-0.

Mr. Miller made a motion to adjourn the meeting, after a second by Mr. McWhorter the motion passed 5-0.

There being no further business Mayor Wright closed the meeting with prayer.
