Regular Session

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Glenn Wright. Members present were Mr. Miller, Mr. McWhorter, Mr. Lewis, Mr. Moore, and Mrs. Wynn.

Mr. Miller opened the meeting with prayer.

Mr. Miller made a motion to approve the March 7, 2016 regular session minutes as presented, after a second by Mr. McWhorter the motion passed 5-0.
