

March 7, 2016
Regular Session

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Glenn Wright. Members present were Mr. Miller, Mr. McWhorter, Mrs. Wynn, and Mr. Lewis.

Mr. McWhorter opened the meeting with prayer.

Mr. Miller made a motion to approve the February 15, 2016 regular session minutes as presented, after a second by Mr. McWhorter the motion passed 3-0-1 with Mr. Lewis abstaining.

Lamar Callaway gave an update on the water plant and presented three bids for the installation of a new high service pump and motor, but was directed to acquire additional bids for only the wiring portion of the installation.

City Manager Postell discussed the plans to upgrade the east and west alleyways, and stated that there have been several concerns from business owners along the west alleyway concerning parking and public safety. City Manager is recommending that the City acquire the alleyway property because of the discontent and safety issues that are being caused. The preliminary ground work has already been done and the majority of the business owners are in support. Mr. Miller made a motion authorizing City Manager Postell to move forward and acquire an improvement plan for the West Alleyway, after a second by Mrs. Wynn the motion passed 4-0.

Mrs. Wynn made a motion to approve March 28, 2016 as the Annual Clean-up day for the city, after a second by Mr. McWhorter the motion passed 4-0.

Mrs. Eula Davis and students from the Boys and Girls Club were present, they are currently studying state and local politics and attended a city council meeting to get a better understanding on the operations of local government.

Mr. Lewis made a motion to enter in Executive Session, after a second by Mr. McWhorter the motion passed 4-0.

No action was taken in Executive Session. Legal matters were discussed. Mr. Lewis made a motion authorizing Mayor Wright to sign an affidavit regarding Executive Session, after a second by Mr. McWhorter the motion passed 4-0.

Mr. Lewis made a motion to adjourn the meeting, after a second by Mr. McWhorter the motion passed 4-0.

There being no further business, Mr. Lewis closed the meeting with prayer.
