

ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

City of Greensboro-Meadow Crest Road Waterline Extension

Sealed Proposals for the Meadow Crest Road Waterline Extension Project for the City of Greensboro will be received by the OWNER at City Hall, 212 N. Main Street, Greensboro, GA, until 2:00 PM o'clock, eastern standard time, on November 1, 2022. The OWNER will evaluate all bids received and publicly opened and read aloud. The CONTRACTOR selected will be notified in writing by the OWNER. No bid may be withdrawn after the closing time for the receipt of bids for a period of sixty (60) calendar days.

Project consists of a Unit Price bid for the extension of a new 12-inch waterline along Meadow Crest Road; all site work required including, but not limited to, clearing and grubbing; appurtenances; pipeline installation, water service installation; site final grading and seeding all as further described in the Plans and Contract Documents.

Payment of the Contract Amount will be made on a periodic basis on applications for payment from the Contractor and approved by the ENGINEER based on work accomplished, products furnished and products stored on the site.

Bonds: All bids must be accompanied by a Bid Bond in an amount not less than five percent (5%) of the amount bid. The Successful Bidder, if awarded the Contract, will be required to furnish a Performance Bond and Payment Bond, each in the amount of one hundred percent (100%) of the Contract amount. The OWNER reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to waive formalities, to re-advertise, or to procure the project by other means.

Contractors bidding on this Project and their Sub-Contractors will be required to comply with all Federal, State, territorial, and local laws. Bidder must comply with Executive Order No. 11246 as amended, entitled "Equal Employment Opportunity" and with the Copeland Anti-Kickback Act (18 U.S.C 874) as supplemented in the Department of Labor Regulations (29 CFR, Part 3).

Successful Bidder will be required to perform Work as the Prime Contractor. Work performed by Prime Contractor shall be 50% minimum.

* Surety companies executing Bonds must appear on the Treasury Department's most current list (Circular 570 as amended) and be authorized to transact business in the state where the project is located.
