

Boil Water Notice

The City of Greensboro Water System has experience a service interruption on April 13, 2019, due to a 6 inch water main break at 1950 South Main Street, Greensboro, Ga. The water pressures in part of our system dropped to below standards of 20 PSI. When this occurs a potential health hazard may exist in these areas of low pressures from backflow and/or back-siphonage of water of unknown quality into the water distribution system.

In order to protect the public from a potential health hazard, all citizens that have experienced water outages and/or low water pressures are advised to “boil” all water prior to use for drinking, cooking, or preparing baby food. The water should be boiled for at least one minute after reaching a rolling boil. Citizens should continue to boil their water until they are notified by The City of Greensboro Water System the system has been restored to full operation, and that the microbiological quality of the water in the distribution system is safe for human consumption.
