

June 21, 2021
Regular Session

The Greensboro City Council meeting was called to order by Mayor Glenn Wright. Council members present were Mr. McWhorter, Mr. Miller, Mr. Moore, and Mr. Smith was out of town but called in by telephone.

Mr. Moore opened the meeting with prayer.

Mr. Miller made the motion to approve the June 7, 2021, Regular Session Minutes as presented, after a second by Mr. McWhorter the motion was approved 4-0.

Chief Monford and Assistant Chief Nelson was present to give an update on the Police Department. Assistant Chief Tommy Nelson discussed his statistic and crime report for the last quarter report. He stated that there has not been an increase in crimes which remains low within the city limits. He also discussed the number of citations that have been written in the last quarter. Chief Monford introduced Officer Lamondo Veal and Officer Vincent Turiano, two new patrol officers with the department. He also updated the Mayor and Council on the operations of the Police Department.

Katrina Breeding was present and spoke in opposition of a beer and wine license being issued for the Hilltop Grocery located at 2071 Martin Luther King Jr. Drive. She stated that a license does not need to be issued because property values may be devalued and there are several other places to purchase beer and wine in the county. She further stated that this store is located too close to the Boys and Girls club and citizens that pay taxes deserve to have their best interests looked after.

The second reading of the ordinance to annex property located on Old Union Point Road tax parcel 0860000460 and 0860000480 was done.

Mr. Moore made a motion to table the request to annex until further information could be received, after a second by Mr. McWhorter the motion was approved 4-0.

Zoning Administrator, Rick Zeier gave an update on the Architectural Review Board approval of the Dollar General Store on East Broad Street.

Mr. Andrew Boswell made comments on the project. He stated that he has no objection to the project and feels that the surrounding buildings need to make changes to be more pleasant and attractive for new businesses to come into the area.

Unfinished Business

Mayor Wright nominated Ms. Cynthia Rivers to fill the unexpired term of Ms. Shirley Wynn and Mr. Smith nominated Mr. David Neal, Mr. McWhorter made the motion to accept the recommendation from Mayor Wright and appoint Cynthia Rivers to the Greensboro City Council and fill the unexpired term of Ms. Shirley Wynn, after a second by Mr. Miller the motion was approve 4-0.

Mr. McWhorter made the motion to adjourn the meeting, after a second by Mr. Miller the motion was approved 4-0.

There being no further business Mr. Miller closed the meeting with prayer.
