Regular Session

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Glenn Wright. Council members present were Mr. Smith, Mr. Moore, and Mr. Miller. Mr. McWhorter was out of town and phoned in to the meeting.

Mr. Smith opened the meeting with prayer.

Mr. Moore made the motion to approve the May 17, 2021, regular session minutes as presented after a second by Mr. Miller the motion was approved 4-0.

Mr. Miller made the motion to approve the May 17, 2021, executive session minutes as presented, after a second by Mr. Smith the motion was approved 4-0.

Johnny Porter gave his Supervisor's report. He updated the Mayor and Council on the manpower for the department, he stated that his department is still short staff, and he is advertising the position in the newspaper. The resurfacing for Railroad Street and Armor Circle was bid out and should be completed in the next month.

Sufi Haider the new owner of the Hilltop Grocery was present, and he is requesting a beer and wine license. City Manger Postell made the recommendation to approve the request and grant the license. Mr. Smith made the motion to table the request until further investigation can be done on the previous ownership, after a second by Mr. Miller the motion passed 4-0.

Mr. Miller made the motion to approve the Pickin on the Greene Street closure request as presented, after a second by Mr. Smith the motion was approved 4-0.

Mr. Miller made the motion to accept the recommendation from the Greensboro Planning and Zoning Board and rezone tax parcel 0860000460 and 0860000480 from A-1 Agricultural District to CPUD Commercial Planned Unit Development after a second by Mr. Smith the motion passed 4-0.

The first reading of the ordinance to annex tax parcel 0860000460 and 0860000480 was done.
