Regular Session

The Greensboro City Council Regular Session was called to order by Mayor Glenn Wright. Council Members present were Mr. McWhorter, Mr. Miller, Mr. Moore, Mrs. Wynn, and Mr. Smith.

Mr. Moore opened the meeting with prayer.

Mr. Miller made the motion to approve the December 21, 2020 Regular Session Minutes as presented after a second by Mr. Moore the motion was approved 5-0.

Brenda Burke gave a report on the Wastewater Treatment Plant. She discussed the different reports that are due in 2021. She stated that the plant operation is going good at this time. She also stated that she will need to hire a driver for the sludge truck and purchase a tractor for her department.

Bill Graden appeared before the City Council after his request was tabled from the December 21, 2020 Regular Session meeting. He is requesting support from the City of Greensboro to give the Boys and Girls Club \$10,000 of SPLOST funds for the next 5 years. This issue has been discussed at the past several meetings.

T.J. McHurrell spoke in favor of the request and asked the Mayor and Council for support. Mr. Smith made the motion to approve the request from Bill Graden and grant \$10,000 of SPLOST funds for the next five years to assist with the Boys and Girls Club Capital Campaign. The motion failed for a lack of a second.
