The Greensboro City Council Regular Session was called to order by Mayor Glenn Wright. Council Members present were Mr. McWhorter, Mr. Smith, Ms. Rivers, Mr. Moore, and Mr. Miller.

Mr. Smith opened the meeting with prayer.

Mr. Smith made the motion to approve the August 2, 2021 Regular Session Minutes as presented after a second by Mr. Miller the motion was approved 5-0.

Mr. McWhorter made the motion to approve the August 2, 2021 Executive Session Minutes as presented, after a second by Mr. Smith the motion was approved 5-0.

Tyia Alexander made a request for a Bottle House License for her business that will be located at 115 East Broad Street. She will not sell or serve any alcoholic beverages, but her clients will be allowed to bring in an alcoholic beverage if they choose too. Mr. Smith made the motion to approve the Bottle House license, after a second by Mr. Miller the motion was approved 5-0.
