Regular Session

The Regular Session of the Greensboro City Council was called to order by Mayor Glenn Wright. Members present were Ms. Rivers, Mr. Moore Telephonically, Mr. Miller, & Mr. Smith, Mayor Wright opened the meeting with prayer.

Mr. Miller made a motion to approve the Regular Session minutes of August 19, 2021. After a second by Mr. Smith, the motion passed 4-0.

Mr. Smith made a motion to approve the Executive Session Minutes of August 19, 2021. After a second by Mr. Miller, the motion passed 4-0.

Lamar Callaway was scheduled for a supervisor's report but was unable to attend. Mayor Wright ordered that he be rescheduled for another date.

Marvin Nunally was scheduled to give a Manufactures Ready Presentation but was unable to attend due to car trouble.

Mamie Hillman made a request to close a portion of Northeast Street on October 16, 2021 from 10:00 am until Noon. Mr. Smith made a motion to approve the road closure after consulting the City Manager and Police Chief on the safest and most convenient way to close the street. After a second by Mr. Miller, the motion passed 4-0.

The second reading of the Ordinance to Amend the code to Impose a Dispersal Standard on Varsity Stores was read. Mr. Smith made a motion to approve the ordinance. After a second by Mr. Miller, the motion passed 4-0.

The second reading of the Ordinance to Amend the code to Limit Through Trucks on portions of Greene Street was read. Mr. Miller made a motion to approve the ordinance. After a second by Mr. Smith, the motion passed 4-0.

The formal introduction of the FY 2021 – 2022 was made by the City Manager.

The City Manager informed the Mayor and Council that the new basketball court was delayed due to supply chain problems related to the Pandemic.

Mr. Smith made a motion to adjourn the meeting, after a second by Ms. Rivers the motion passed 4-0.
