Regular Session

The Greensboro City Council Regular Session was called to order by Mayor Glenn Wright. Members present were Mr. McWhorter, Ms. Rivers, Mr. Miller, Mr. Moore, and Mr. Smith.

Mr. Miller opened the meeting with prayer.

Mr. Miller made a motion to approve the September 7, 2021 Regular Session minutes as presented after a second by Mr. Smith the motion was approved 4-0-1 with Mr. McWhorter abstaining.

Johnny Porter was present to give his Supervisor's Report for the Street Department. He stated that he recently lost two employees but since the workload is slowing down his manpower is good at this time. Some of the department's equipment has been down for several weeks because certain parts have been hard to find due to the age of the equipment. He is looking to purchase a new packing truck for his department. Mr. Porter addressed the issue on Armour Circle, and he stated that his department is working to repair some of the issues that were caused from the recent resurfacing of the street.

Marvin Nunnally gave a Manufacture Ready presentation.

Jovetta Smith addressed her concerns with the conditions of Armor Circle since the resurfacing of the Street and has asked if the issue could be resolved soon.

Cail Hammons recommended that Anna O'Neal be appointed to the Greensboro Historic Preservation Commission. Mr. Miller made a motion to accept the recommendation, after a second by Mr. Smith the motion was approved 5-0.

Mr. McWhorter made a motion to enter into an agreement with Allen Smith Consulting to provide grant writing services for a CDBG grant, after a second by Mr. Moore the motion was approved 5-0.

Nicole Chillemi made a request for a Special Events Alcohol Permit for an event that will be held at Festival Hall October 8, 2021. Mr. Miller made the motion to approve the request, after a second by Mr. Smith the motion was approved 5-0.
