January 3, 2022
Regular Session

The Regular Session of the Greensboro City Council was called to order by Mayor Corey Williams. Council Members present were Mr. Miller, Mrs. Rivers, Mr. Rowland, Mr. Neal, and Mr. Moore.

Minister Wayne Lumpkin opened the meeting with prayer.

Mr. Neal made the motion to approve the December 20, 2021 regular session minutes as presented, after a second by Mr. Moore the motion was approved 5-0.

Mr. Moore made the motion to approve the December 20, 2021 executive session minutes as presented, after a second by Mr. Miller the motion was approved 5-0.

Mr. Miller made the motion to reappoint Mr. Larry Postell as City Manager, after a second by Mr. Neal the motion was approved 5-0.

Targie Folds, Executive Director, of the Greene County Family Connection was present and discussed the role that the Family Connection organization has served in the community as well as with the families of school age children. She stated that the city has had a partnership with the organization over the years, Targie stated the organization is state funded and needs a fiscal agent to manage funds and she requested for the City of Greensboro to serve as the fiscal agent. The Greene County Board of Education served as the agent for the past 10 years. Mr. Neal made the motion to approve the request from Targie Folds, after a second by Mr. Miller the motion was approved 5-0.

Unfinished Business

City Manager discussed new bank signature card and explained that in addition to the Mayor, the mayor would need to appoint an alternate person. Mayor Williams nominated Mr. Neal. Mr. Miller made the motion to accept the nomination from the mayor, after a second by Mrs. Rivers the motion was approved 4-0-1 with Mr. Neal abstaining.

Annie Grant thanked the city staff that participated in the Educational Forum at the Greene County High School.

Sabrina Rankin was present to check on the status of her Business License application. No action was taken someone will follow up with her in a couple of days.

Mayor Williams made a recommendation to appoint Mr. Neal as the Mayor-ProTem. Mr. Miller made a motion to accept the recommendation of the mayor, after a second by Mrs. Rivers the motion was approved 4-0-1 with Mr. Neal abstaining.

Mr. Neal made the motion to enter Executive Session, after a second by Mr. Moore the motion was approved 5-0.

No action was taken in Executive Session 1 legal matter and 1 personnel matter was discussed. Mr. Moore made the motion authorizing Mayor Williams to sign an Executive Session affidavit, after a second by Mr. Miller the motion was approved 5-0.

Mrs. Rivers made the motion to adjourn the meeting, after a second by Mr. Miller the motion was approved 5-0.

There being no further business Mr. Moore closed the meeting with prayer.
