

May 16, 2022
Regular Session

The Regular Session of the Greensboro City Council was called to order by Mayor Corey Williams. Members present were Mrs. Rivers, Mr. Moore, Mr. Miller, Mr. Neal, and Mr. Rowland.

Mayor Williams opened the meeting with prayer.

Mr. Miller made a motion to approve the minutes of May 6, 2022. After a second by Ms. Rivers, the motion passed 5-0.

Mr. Miller made a motion to approve the Executive Session Minutes of April 18, 2022. After a second by Ms. Rivers, the motion passed 5-0.

Street Supervisor, Johnny Porter gave his supervisor's report. Mr. Porter discussed the workforce, streets needing resurfacing and equipment.

Kendrick Ward presented the road closures for Picking on the Greene to be held June 17th, 2022. Closing Main and Greene Street beginning at 1:30 and West Greene to Mr. C's beginning at 4:30. Mr. Miller made a motion to close the road; after a second by Mr. Moore, the motion passed 5-0.

Bids for stabilization of the floor of Festival Hall were presented to the Mayor and Council with the recommendation of accepting Callaway Site Services' bid of \$125,800. Mr. Moore made a motion to accept Callaway's bid. After a second by Mr. Rowland, the motion passed 5-0.

Mayor Williams made the appointment of Robyn Mapp to become the City Clerk for the City of Greensboro. Mr. Miller made a motion to accept the appointment. After a second by Mr. More, the motion passed 5-0.

Mayor Williams made the appointment of Marcus Cunningham to be Wastewater Supervisor. Mr. Neal made a motion to approve the appointment. After a second by Mr. Rowland, the motion passed 5-0.

The City Manager recommended Mr. Phil Sutton be contracted to assist with LOST negotiations. Mr. Moore made a motion to accept the contract. After a second by Mr. Miller, the motion passed 5-0.

Mayor Williams asked the Council Members to be thinking about a City Mission Statement.

Mr. Miller made a motion to go into Executive Session. After a second by Mr. Moore, the motion passed 5-0.

After returning to regular session, one personnel matter was discussed, Mr. Neal made a motion to approve Mayor Williams to sign an affidavit to that effect. After a second by Mr. Neal, the motion passed 5-0.

Mr. Neal made a motion to adjourn the meeting; after a second by Mr. Rowland the motion passed 5-0.

There being no further business, Mr. Miller closed the meeting with prayer.
