

January 18, 2022
Regular Session

The Greensboro City Council Regular Session meeting was called to order by Mayor Corey Williams. Council members present were Mr. Neal, Mrs. Rivers, Mr. Miller, Mr. Moore, and Mr. Rowland.

Mrs. Meg Brown, Pastor of the First Presbyterian Church opened the meeting with a prayer.

Mr. Neal made the motion to approve the January 3, 2022, Regular Session minutes as presented, after a second by Mrs. Rivers the motion was approved 5-0.

Mr. Miller made the motion to approve the January 3, 2022, Regular Session minutes as presented, after a second by Mrs. Rivers the motion was approved 5-0.

Johnny Porter gave an update on the Street Department. He addressed the issue on Armor Circle and stated that the department will be able to proceed with the repairs when the ground has had to time to dry out. He also discussed several streets that need resurfacing. He stated that his department is currently short staff but should be good until spring and he will need to hire an additional 3-4 employees. The equipment for his department is good but the department will need a PAC truck the current one is an older model and parts are hard to find.

Mr. Robert Motley gave the state of Public Housing. He stated that a replacement needs to be appointed to fill the vacancy of the late Mrs. Lenester Chester who served on the board for over 40 years. The current members are Johnnie Satterfield, Felix Parks, Barbara Johnson, and Sam Harrison. Mr. Motley stated that the Greensboro Housing Authority has been rated as a high-performance Housing Authority for the past 19 years and he also discussed several programs offered to tenants of public housing. Mr. Motley presented the city with a PILOT check in the amount of \$10,800.
