

February 21, 2022

Regular Session

The Greensboro City Council Regular Session meeting was called to order by Mayor Corey Williams. Council members present were Mr. Neal, Mrs. Rivers, Mr. Miller, Mr. Moore, and Mr. Rowland.

Mayor Corey Williams opened the meeting with a prayer.

Mr. Miller made the motion to approve the February 7, 2022, Regular Session minutes as presented, after a second by Mrs. Rivers the motion was approved 5-0.

Mr. Neal made the motion to approve the February 7, 2022, Executive Session minutes as presented, after a second by Mr. Rowland the motion was approved 5-0.

Mr. Moore made the motion to approve the February 14, 2022, Call Meeting minutes as presented, after a second by Mr. Miller the motion was approved 5-0.

Lamar Callaway was not present for the Supervisor Report

Beer & Wine license was approved for the MLK Market located at 1340 Martin Luther King Jr. Drive. (Sufi Haider) Mr. Miller motioned to approve the license, with a second by Mrs. Rivers the motion was approved 5-0. Mr. Moore inquired about the use of slot machines at this location, Mr. Haider informed the council that he is waiting on his Lottery State license.

(Linda Llyod) Economic Justice Coalition was not present.

Mr. Miller made the motion to approve the appointment of Mr. Neal to the Lake Oconee Area Development Authority, with a second by Mr. Moore the motion was approved 4-0 (Mr. Neal excluded)

The second reading of the ordinance amending duties from the position of Clerk and City Manager. Mr. Moore made the motion to approve, with a second by Mr. Miller the motion was approved 5-0.

Unfinished Business:

Mr. Miller inquired about the progress of the basketball court. Mr. Postell stated that the company working on it should continue this week.

New Business:

Mr. Moore stated that when it rains at the new Dollar General, red mud is being washed down 278, and Thomas Drive needs proper lighting. Also, there is a deep fall off about 2 feet deep in the curb of the new Dollar General. Mr. Postell stated he will follow up with the contractors.

Mr. Postell made a request for 2 Special Events Beer and Wine Permits being held at Festival Hall. The Jazz Festival being held on March 3rd was motioned by Mr. Miller and after a second by Mrs. Rivers the motion was approved 5-0. The Night of Laughter being held on March 4th was motioned by Mrs. Rivers and after a second by Mr. Moore the motion was approved 5-0.

Mr. Miller wanted an update on the water run-off on Adrian Circle, specifically 1070 Adrian Drive. Mr. Postell stated he along with the street supervisor would look at it. Mr. Rowland stated she might need a back flow preventor.

There were no public comments.

Mr. Miller made the motion to enter executive session on 1 personnel matter, after a second by Mr. Rowland the motion was approved 5-0.

1 personnel matter was discussed. Mr. Moore made the motion authorizing Mayor Williams to sign a closed meeting affidavit, after a second by Mr. Miller the motion was approved 5-0.

Mrs. Rivers made the motion to adjourn the meeting, after a second by Mr. Miller the motion was approved 5-0.

There being no further business Mayor Williams closed the meeting with prayer.
