Regular Session

The Greensboro City Council Regular Session meeting was called to order by Mayor Corey Williams. Council members present were Mr. Neal, Mrs. Rivers, Mr. Moore, and Mr. Rowland.

Mayor Williams opened the meeting with prayer.

Mr. Moore made the motion to approve the March 21, 2022 Regular Session minutes as presented, after a second by Mr. Rowland the motion was approved 5-0.

Freddie Evans gave an update on the Water Department. He stated that the department has been repairing aging water and sewer lines as well as water leaks when needed. The department overall is doing good but is in need of new vehicles.

Mr. Neal made the motion to approve a Beer & Wine license, Bottle house license, and Ancillary Wine Tasting license to Kelly Parham for the Lake and Local business located at 104 South Main Street, after a second by Mr. Moore the motion was approved 4-0.

Mr. Moore made the motion to approve the request from Mamie Hillman and allow the African American Museum to host an event at Festival Hall on September 3rd with a city approved day, after a second by Mr. Rowland the motion was approved 4-0.

Mr. Moore made a motion to accept the recommendation from City Manager Postell and appoint Mayor Williams as the voting delegate and City Manager Postell as the alternate for the Municipal Gas Authority Annual Election which will be held in May, after a second by Mr. Rivers the motion was approved 4-0.

Mrs. Rivers made the motion to approve a special events alcohol permit for beer, wine, and liquor for Festival Hall for an event on April 29th, after a second by Mr. Nel the motion was approved 4-0.

There was no unfinished business.

New Business

Mr. Moore made the motion to approve the resolution to designate Juneteenth as a city paid holiday, after a second by Mr. Neal the motion was approved 4-0.

Public Comments

Felicia Rush addressed the Mayor and Council on the status of the audit and the code enforcement department.

Roosevelt Glover owner of the Community Connections Newspaper was present to introduce himself to the Mayor and Council and stated that his newspaper will highlighting the best of areas in the county.

Mr. Moore made the motion to enter Executive Session, after a second by Mrs. Rivers the motion was approved 4-0.
