Regular Session

The Greensboro City Council Regular Session Meeting was called to order by Corey Williams. Council members present were Mr. Neal, Mrs. Rivers, Mr. Rowland, Mr. Miller, and Mr. Moore.

Mayor Williams opened the meeting with a prayer.

Mr. Miller made the motion to approve the June 6, 2022 Regular Session Minutes as presented, after a second by Mrs. Rivers the motion was approved 5-0.

Assistant Chief Tommy Nelson was present to give an update on the Police Department. He discussed different events taking place in the next few weeks at the Police Department. He also discussed the citation report for the past several months and stated that gun related incidents are down.
