Regular Session

The Greensboro City Council Regular Session Meeting was called to order by Corey Williams. Council members present were Mr. Neal, Mrs. Rivers, Mr. Moore, and Mr. Miller via telephone.

Mr. Neal opened the meeting with a prayer.

Mr. Neal made the motion to approve the July 5, 2022 Regular Session Minutes as presented, after a second by Mrs. Rivers the motion was approved 4-0.

Freddie Evans updated the Mayor and Council on the state of the Water Department. He reported that the department has been working to repair several small leaks. He also discussed purchasing vehicles for his department.

Claire Beckley, the Planning and Zoning consultant was present to present the annexation request from Ravi Patel to annex 9.33 acres on Lake Oconee Parkway/ Highway 44 into the city limits. The tax parcel is 0520000200. The property is vacant and currently zoned Commercial under Greene County zoning designation and is surrounded by property that is zoned both Commercial and Agricultural. There are currently no intentions for the property at this time, the annexation is to avoid an island. The Planning and Zoning Board forwarded a recommendation to approve the annexation of this property into the city limits of Greensboro and designate it as B-2 General Highway Commercial Highway Oriented District. Mr. Moore made the recommendation to accept the recommendation from the Planning and Zoning Board after a second by Mr. Neal the motion was approved 4-0.
