Mrs. Wynn opened the meeting with prayer.

Mr. Moore made a motion to approve the May 21, 2018 regular session minutes as presented, after a second by Mr. Miller the motion passed 5-0.

Brenda Burke gave an update on the Sewer Plant. She stated all test have been completed and that she received a bid for the cleanup of the pond.
